Bright'n Green is a net-zero energy building, utilizing wind turbines and solar panels for the generation of electricity, HRV's, water reclamation systems, photovoltaic panels for generation of domestic hot water, four 100-foot deep geothermal wells for heating, R-48 insulated structural insulated panels, which also provide the exterior finish for the building, triple pane insulated windows carrying a U value of 0.17, and a Solar Heat Gain Coefficient of 0.28 www.brightngreen.com
